Grouping animals

Fish

Fish live in **water** and have **gills**, **scales** and **fins** on their body.



Birds

Birds have **feathers**, **beaks** and **wings**.
Most birds **can fly**.



Mammals

Mammals have **fur or hair**.
They drink **milk** from their mother
when they are young.



Amphibians

Amphibians are born in **water** but then
develop **lungs** and live on **land**.



Reptiles

Reptiles are **cold-blooded** animals with
scales that **live on land**.

Carnivores just eat **other animals** (meat).



Herbivores

Herbivores just **eat plants**.



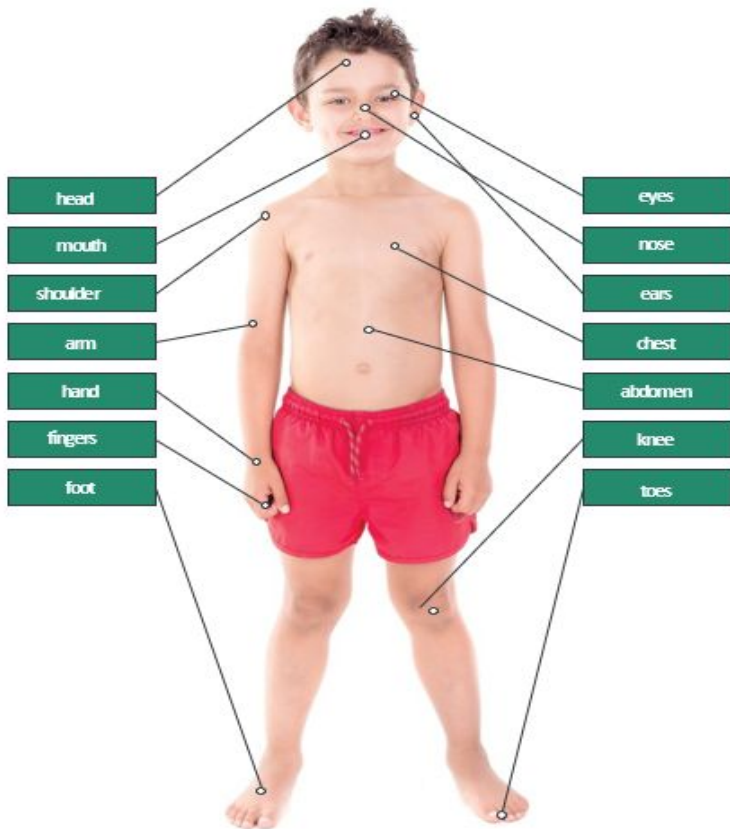
Omnivores
